<b>Bank Account</b>	All entries must be paid for online via PAYFAST on the KPC website.
<b>Refunds</b>	No Refunds will be given after closing date of entries. Entries withdrawn before close of entries date will be refunded less PAYFAST fees. Should inclement weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances necessitate the cancelling of the show by the organising Committee, 80% of the entry fees will be refunded.
<b>Prize Money</b>	A minimum of 60% net of entry fees less levies and VAT for Open Classes and 40% net of entry fees less levies and VAT for Provincial Classes
<b>Restrictions</b>	The Organising Committee in consultation with the SASA representative reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide classes should this be necessary.
<b>Substitutions</b>	A substitution us of <b>either</b> horse or rider. No buying or selling of entries will be accepted after 4th September 2022.
<b>Dress</b>	Competitors are required to be correctly dressed at all times.
<b>Catering</b>	Catering will be available at the show.
<b>Parades and Prize Givings</b>	Except in circumstances where special dispensation has been obtained from the Show Director, competitors must take part in any parade or display or Prize giving. Failure to do so may result in forfeiture of any Prizemoney, Grading/Qualification Points and/or Trophies.
<b>Stabling</b>	R200 per day/night OR R1000 Duration of the show (6th – 11th September) Initial bedding is included. Additional bedding will be available at the show office for the competitor's own account. <b>NO PADDOCKS ALLOWED AT ALL</b> ALL COMPETITORS needing stabling MUST COMPLETE the <b>STABLE BOOKING FORM</b> attached to this schedule
<b>Horse Inspection</b>	Horse Inspection on 7 <sup>th</sup> September for all Open and Open Team Horses.
<b>Rules &amp; Regulations</b>	The event will be run under SASA and SAEF rules unless otherwise stated.

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Competitors may only ride one horse in each class, except in the Working Classes, where they may ride up to three horses.</li> <li>2. All Riders and Horses must be registered with a Club, SAEF and SASA. Membership forms may be obtained on the SASA website <a href="http://www.showingsa.co.za">www.showingsa.co.za</a> or from <a href="mailto:admin@showingsa.co.za">admin@showingsa.co.za</a>. Temporary SASA Membership will not be allowed for any graded classes at this show</li> <li>3. SASA will pay entry fees for SASA EDTS competitors in all classes. That includes In Hand and Under Saddle classes. The competitor must be an EDTS member of SASA. Membership is free. EDTS application forms, Rules and Conditions are available at <a href="http://www.showingsa.co.za">www.showingsa.co.za</a> or from <a href="mailto:admin@showingsa.co.za">admin@showingsa.co.za</a> EDTS competitors will earn EDTS Victor Ludorum points.</li> <li>4. Working Hunters will be required to jump a course of approximately 8-12 fences, one of which will be a combination.</li> <li>5. Should a competitor qualify more than one horse for the championship, he may nominate another rider, who must be a paid-up member of SASA, to show the horse in that championship. However, the competitor must do the individual test required in the Championship.</li> <li>6. All classes will be run under SASA Rules –22<sup>nd</sup> Edition (Effective 1<sup>st</sup> February 2022)</li> <li>7. EVERY COMPETITOR ENTERING THIS SHOW DOES HEREBY INDEMNIFY ANY JUDGE REGISTERED WITH SASA, OFFICIATING AT THIS SHOW, AGAINST ANY CLAIM OF ANY NATURE FROM ANY CAUSE WHATSOEVER.</li> <li>8. Registered SASA Instructors will earn Victor Ludorum points for pupils.</li> <li>9. Open Adult Horses will be ridden by the Judge</li> <li>10. Heights of Horses must be stated in Horses passport.</li> <li>11. The minimum age of horses shown under saddle shall be 3 years.</li> <li>12. 59.2.1 All competitors, owners and sponsors shall be registered with a club in whose area of jurisdiction they have their principal place of residence, SAEF and SASA and shall be re-registered on 1 January each year. Horses shall be registered with SAEF and SASA.</b></li> <li><b>14. The horse and rider combination will compete as a member of the Province where the rider is resident.</b></li> <li>15. On no account, and under penalty of disqualification, may any horse take part in any of the showing classes if the horse has been ridden by anyone other than the competitor or judge from the first day of the show until the end of the last class in which that horse competes.</li> <li>16. A deposit of R20 for a number is included in the entry fee. This is refundable to all competitors on condition that the number is returned before the end of the show.</li> </ol>
<b>Objections &amp; Appeals</b>	As per SASA General Regulations 2022, all Objections and Appeals must be lodged with the Show Director in writing within the specified time and accompanied by the required deposit of R750.
<b>Passports</b>	All competitors must have their up-to-date horse passports at the event for inspection at any time. Horses whose passports do not fully comply with the current Government and SASA regulations may be refused permission to compete and asked to leave the venue.
<b>Testing &amp; Checking</b>	Both horses and athletes may be tested by SAEF officials at any time during the show for prohibited substances
<b>Conduct Yellow Cards</b>	Any owner or rider who attempts to interfere with or influence judges, officials, or stewards, or who at any time on the show grounds uses any contemptuous or abusive language to any of the judges, officials or stewards will forfeit his/her rights to any prizes to which they might otherwise be entitled and will receive a yellow card which will require them to remove themselves and their horse from the grounds pending a disciplinary enquiry.
<b>Indemnity Responsibility</b>	All persons participating at this event do so at their own risk and will have no claim against Kyalami Park Club (KPC), South African Equestrian Federation (SAEF), SASA (Showing Association of South Africa including any officials, employees, members, affiliated bodies, show-holding bodies or sponsors of KPC, SASA or SAEF, for any damage or loss of property or death or injury of persons suffered during or in connection with this event from any cause whatsoever. Being placed in a Novice class may be considered as being qualified to compete at this level. Notice by Provincial Bodies of their intention to participate in Team Championships must be sent to the SASA Chairman <b>Shirley Sadlier at <a href="mailto:president@showingsa.co.za">president@showingsa.co.za</a></b> by no later than the 20 August 2022. Details/composition of nominated teams is laid down in the SASA Rules. Provincial Committees shall nominate their teams with full details of their team, in writing, to the Organising Committee of the event and to the Discipline Association, not later than SEVEN clear days before the first competition day of the event. Each Provincial Body may only enter one team in the Inter- provincial team event and only one in the Challenge Team event. Team managers must submit their final Team selection from those nominated, at the briefing on Tuesday 6th September 2022.</li> <li>• The rules governing the substitutions of team horses and /or riders are laid down in the SASA Showing Rules.</li> <li>• No Cross entry of horse and rider combinations in the Inter-Provincial and Challenge Team events.
