| AGE CLASSIFICATION OF RIDERS | A horse or pony and rider combination may only ride in one Section: Pony Rider: Athletes who may take part in Competitions for Pony Riders until the end of the year they reach the age of sixteen (16) riding Ponies. Children: Athletes may take part in Children's' Competitions until the end of the year they reach the age of fourteen (14) riding Horses Junior: Athletes may take part in Competitions for Juniors from the year they reach the age of fourteen (14) until the end of the year they reach the age of eighteen (18). Young Rider: Athletes who may take part in Competitions for Young Riders from the beginning of the year they reach the age of sixteen (16) until the end of the year they reach the age of twenty-one (21). |

| NUMBER OF TESTS PER DAY | No horse / Pony may compete in more than 2 tests per day up to and including Elementary-Medium level. Horses / Ponies may only compete in one test per day at DSA Medium level and above. |
| REGISTERED GRADE | A Horse / Pony may compete in one grade higher than the grade in which it is registered. |
| VARIATION OF PROGRAM | The advertised programme and classes will be adhered to as far as possible. However, in the light of unforeseen circumstances the Organising Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, divide or postpone any class providing such alteration is within the framework of Rules. No refunds after closing date of entries. |
| ARENA FAMILIARIZATION | Arenas will be open during certain times for Arena Familiarization. Times will be advised & published with the Final Timetable. No teaching or riding of dressage tests in this time will be permitted. Please be considerate to allow for everyone to be given an opportunity to practice in the arenas. |
| RIDING TIMES | Once riders with more than one horse have been timetabled, a random draw will establish the order of riding. The onus is on the competitor to check the final starting order before the start of the class at the arena that the classes are to be held. Any clashes with a rider competing in another discipline must be brought to the attention of the dressage organizer well before the start of the class. |
| PRIZE GIVING CEREMONIES | All Prize winners are obliged to attend prize giving correctly dressed. PRIZE GIVING IS COMPULSORY. If you do not attend prize giving you may forfeit your prize money and any gifts for donations from sponsors may be reallocated. The show holder will not be responsible for keeping your prizes for you or getting your prizes and gifts to you. |
| BRIDLE NUMBERS | Will be allocated and this number must be attached to the LEFT-HAND SIDE of the halter/head collar and/or to the numnah/Bridle at all times when the horse is outside the stable. |
| RULES & REGULATIONS | The event will be run under DSA rules - February 2023 (updated 5 th April 2023) and SAEF General Regulations January 2022 unless otherwise stated. FEI rules and including the SAEF Veterinary Regulations & Directives. |
| CALLERS & WHIPS | Please check each class description for the relevant caller and whip rules. |
| FREESTYLE MUSIC | This must be emailed to dressage@kyalamiparkclub.co.za and owen@ultimo.co.za by the closing date of entries. The onus is on the rider to ensure that he/she has checked his/her music with the sound engineer. Testing times will be advised in program |
| PASSPORTS | All competitors must have their up-to-date horse passports at the event for inspection at any time. Horses whose passports do not fully comply with the current Government, FEI, DSA, and General regulations may be refused permission to compete and asked to leave the venue. |
| AFRICAN HORSE SICKNESS & EQUINE FLU | All horses must be vaccinated with AHS vaccine and with Equine Influenza and in accordance with the regulations laid out in the equestrian rules. Horses that do not comply may be refused permission to compete and can be asked to leave the show grounds. |

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| TRAVEL PASSPORTS | All horses travelling from the Western Cape need to obtain a travel permit from the state vet. SEE INFORMATION IN THIS SCHEDULE |
| TESTING AND CHECKING | Both horses and athletes may be tested at any time during the show for prohibited substances. Saddlery and bits may be checked before and/or after competitors enter/leave the arena. |
| SUBSTITUTIONS | As per DSA rules. Substitutions may not take place after the first day of the show. |
| OBJECTIONS & APPEALS | As per SAEF General Regulations 1 January 2022, all Objections and Appeals must be lodged with the Organising Committee (OC) or DSA Representative in writing within a specified time and accompanied by the required deposit as per the specific protocols applicable to this show, |
| SCHOOLING OF HORSES | Under no account, and under penalty of disqualification, may any horse, except those ridden by Para Dressage athletes (where allowed), take part in any class should that horse have been schooled under saddle by anyone other than the competitor concerned from the start of the 1st day of the show until the end of that horse's last class. |
| SADDLERY & DRESS | The event will be run under current DSA Rules 1 January 2022 and SAEF General Regulations 1 January 2022 unless otherwise stated. |
| CONDUCT | Any owner or rider who attempts to interfere with or influence judges, officials or stewards, or who at any time on the show grounds uses any contemptuous or abusive language to any of the judges, officials or stewards will forfeit his/her rights to any prizes to which they might otherwise be entitled and will receive a yellow card which will require them to remove themselves and their horse from the grounds pending a disciplinary enquiry. |
| DOGS | No dog may be on Kyalami Park Club grounds if it is not on a leash at all times. |
