AMENDMENTS TO CLASSES	The organisers reserve the right to cancel, divide, postpone or combine classes provided such amendments are not in conflict with the rules. The Organising Committee reserves the right to omit classes which are insufficiently supported.
PRIZE MONEY	Prize Money will be at the discretion of the Organizing Committee but a minimum of R2000 shall be paid to the prize winners of the 2024 Individual Adult Dressage Championship of South Africa as well as to the prize-winners of the 2024 Individual Adult Freestyle Dressage Championship of South Africa as per DSA rules.
ORDER OF RIDING	Once riders with more than one horse have been timetabled, a random draw will establish the order of riding for all the Championships.
NUMBER OF TESTS	No horse may compete in more than 2 tests per day up to and including Elementary level. Horses may only compete in one test per day at DSA Medium level and above.
NUMBER OF ENTRIES	Any class which has twenty-five entries or more will be divided into pools.
NUMBER OF HORSES	A rider may not qualify more than 2 horses for any Championship in any one class, unless at the Organizer's discretion, the lack of numbers and the availability of suitable timetabling permits the rider to ride more than 2 horses in one class. Any rider with multiple entries which complicate the programming may be asked to limit the number of entries.
ELIGIBILITY	A Horse may compete in the grade in which it is registered with DSA or 1 grade higher at closing date of entries. However, horses ridden by Open athletes may ride in the grade the horse is registered or elect to ride up the grades as specified in rule 34:10.6 provided it complies with rule 34.9.0. A horse that is registered in the Big or Medium Tour grades may ride down to any lower Tour grade. No horse/rider combination may enter more than 1 section. An SA Championship title may be won by all SA Citizens holding a valid SA Identity document or SA Passport or a rider that has an SA Residency Permit which entails that he/she is entitled to legally

	reside within the SA borders for more than 6 months annually. Upon request the rider must provide either of the 3 aforementioned documents and must have competed at a minimum of 2 DSA registered graded shows within 6 months prior to the closing date of entries for the show. The DSA Exco will have the final decision as to the eligibility of the rider.
S A CHAMPIONSHIP TITLE MINIMUM PERCENTAGE	If a competitor who is the only entrant for that championship wins a SA Championship, he/she must attain a minimum score of 60% to be awarded the SA Championship title for that grade.
OBLIGATIONS OF PRIZE WINNERS	All prize winners are obliged to attend the Prize Givings. Failure to do so without the written permission of the organizers will result in the forfeiture of all titles and prizes. Only the 2024 Individual Adult Dressage Championship of South Africa, the 2024 Individual Adult Freestyle Dressage Championship of South Africa as well as the Open Team Prize Givings will be mounted. Horses, riders and their grooms are to be correctly turned out and may only wear official day-sheets and advertising. The times for all Prize Giving Ceremonies will be advertised on the programme.
USE OF COMPETITION ARENAS	The competition arenas are out of bounds for schooling from the first day of the show until the last class of the show has finished in that arena. Arena times for familiarization will be posted with the final programme and other additional times will be made available where possible. No teaching or riding of tests in the competition arenas will be permitted during Familiarization. Please be considerate to allow for everyone to be given an opportunity to practice in the arenas.
CALLERS AND WHIPS	A whip and a caller may be used in all Qualifying classes except for FEI Prix St-Georges levels and up, which may use a whip but must ride the qualifying classes from memory. All Preliminary to Medium Tour Championship classes will be ridden from memory. The 2024 Individual Adult Dressage Championship of South Africa will be ridden from memory and without a whip.
HORSE PASSPORTS	All competitors must have their up-to-date horse passports at the event for inspection at any time. Horses whose passports do not fully comply with the current Government, FEI, DSA Rules 2024, SAEF General Regulations 2023 may be refused permission to compete and asked to leave the venue. Passports must be handed into the Show Office on arrival, prior to competing.
HORSE INSPECTIONS	All horses entered in the Big Tour classes and those entered in Open Inter-Provincial Team Championship must present for inspection on Tuesday 17 th September 2024. Times will be advertised on the programme. Any other horse(s) may be called to a horse inspection at the discretion of the OC.
TESTING and CHECKING	Both horses and athletes may be tested at any time during the show for prohibited substances. Saddlery and bits may be checked before and/or after competitors enter/leave the arena.
SUBSTITUTIONS:	As per DSA rules. Substitutions may not take place on or after the 17 th of September 2024, the first day of the show.
OBJECTIONS and APPEALS:	All Objections and Appeals must be lodged with the Organising Committee (OC) or DSA Representative in writing within the specified time and accompanied by the required deposit as per the specific protocols applicable to this show. Please see attached protocols: Appendix A
EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY and INDEMNITY	Neither KPC, nor SAEF, nor DSA, nor their agents, sponsors, partners, employees, officers, officials, members, independent contractors, volunteers or any other persons associated herewith shall be responsible or may be held liable for any loss, damage or injury including consequential losses, suffered by or caused to any person or property on or about the property or premises on which any event, competition, match, practice or related activity or any other activity of whatsoever nature is held, whether or not such loss, damage or injury is occasioned by any act or omission of KPC, it's agents, employees, officers, members, independent contractors, volunteers or any other persons associated herewith or for whose actions they or any of them would be liable in law, or by reason of <i>vis major casus fortuitus</i> , rain or other water, riot, strikes, theft or burglary with or without forcible entry, or by any reason or any condition on or off any grounds, building structures, premises or facilities on or about which any KPC event, competition, function or meeting of whatsoever nature is held, or caused by any sporting activity, or by any other cause of whatsoever nature and howsoever arising. By entering or participating or officiating in any activity of the show, one agrees that all information and particulars supplied are correct, and one agrees to abide by all of the rules and regulations and one agrees that the decision of the organizers is final.
BEHAVIOUR TOWARDS OFFICIALS	Any person who attempts to harass or influence the Judges, Stewards or Officials, or who at any time uses contemptuous or abusive language at the venue, whether to any of the judges, stewards or officials, may forfeit his or her right to any prizes to which he or she may be otherwise entitled. Likewise, abusive or aggressive treatment of horses will not be tolerated. Such perpetrators will be issued a Yellow Card.
DRESS	As per DSA rules except Para Equestrian athletes with specific dress classifications. Identification numbers must be worn on the left-hand side of the bridle or numnah at all times.
SCHOOLING of HORSES	Under no account, and under penalty of disqualification, may any horse, except those ridden by Para Equestrian athletes where allowed, take part in any class should that horse have been schooled under saddle by anyone other than the correctly entered competitor concerned from the start of the 1 st day of the show until the end of that horse's last class.

<p style="text-align: center;">STABLING</p>	<p>Stabling will be available from arrival on Sunday 15th of September until 10 am on Monday morning 23rd September at R1200 for the duration of the show including the initial shavings. Further shavings must be bought by the competitor. Daily stables are available for R230 including initial shavings. Written permission from the OC is required should there be a need to enter or leave the stables outside of these dates. Storage stables, which may not necessarily be next to your allocated stable, may be available on a first come first served basis at R1200 for the duration of the show. Stables allocated may not be changed without the permission of the Stable Manager or the OC in writing. The OC reserves the right to change allocated stables or move horses when necessary. Please indicate on the stabling form if your horse is a stallion and with whom you would like to be stabled next to should this be applicable. Times for sound checks will be in the programme. The ONUS is on the rider to ensure that he/she has submitted his/her music on time and has checked that the music and sound is correct.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">QUALIFYING CLASSES FOR PRELIMINARY TO ELEMENTARY</p>	<p>There will be two qualifying tests offered in each grade from Preliminary to Elementary. The top 15 qualifying horses will be eligible to compete in the Championship; the remaining horses will automatically ride in the Consolation class for that grade. The qualification for the Championship will be determined by the sum of the percentages received in both qualifying tests. The horse and rider combination must be the same for the qualifying competitions and the Championship. Where qualifying competitions are split into more than one pool, all pools must be judged by the same Jury. Competitors riding more than 1 horse in the same grade must compete in the same qualifying pool with all his/her horses. One rider may only ride a maximum of 2 horses in any Championship class - any further qualified horses must ride in the Consolation Class unless at the Organizer's discretion, the lack of numbers and the availability of suitable timetabling permits the rider to ride more than 2 horses in one class. In the classes where the team competition is ridden in conjunction with a qualifying or championship class a competitor shall always ride his team entry horse before his individual entry horse, or horses should he/she have more than one horse in that class. The Victor Ludorum in each grade will be calculated by adding the percentage scores of both of the qualifying classes, the Championship class as well as the Freestyle class in each grade.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">QUALIFYING CLASSES FOR MEDIUM TO BIG TOUR</p>	<p>Should there be more than 15 entries in the Medium – Big Tour classes, the Qualifier class will determine the 15 top riders to compete in the Championship in each level; the remaining horses will automatically ride in the Consolation class for that level. Competitors are not compelled to compete in the qualifying competition but should there be more than 15 competitors, that competitor will automatically ride in the Consolation Class. The Victor Ludorum in each grade will be calculated by adding the percentage scores of the qualifying class, the Championship class as well as the Freestyle class in each grade.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">QUALIFYING FOR PARA-EQUESTRIAN CLASSES</p>	<p>Should there be more than 15 entries in each/any of the Para-Equestrian grades, the Qualifier class will determine the 15 top riders to compete in the Championship in each grade; the remaining horses will automatically ride in the Consolation class for that grade. Competitors are not compelled to compete in the qualifying competition but should there be more than 15 competitors, that competitor will automatically ride in the Consolation Class for that grade. The Para-Equestrian Victor Ludorum will be calculated by adding the percentage scores of the qualifying classes, the Championship classes as well as the Freestyle classes.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">TEAM ENTRIES</p>	<p>Provinces must send an "Intention to Send Team" Form to the Organizing Committee and to the DSA National Office by Monday 26th August 2024. Provinces must submit Final Team Selection to the Organizing Committee by closing date of entries Monday 2nd September 2024. Provinces must confirm final participating combinations and reserve at the Team Declaration on Tuesday 17th September 2024. These can still be substituted from within the Final Team Selected riders up until 1 hour before the start of the event.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">HORSE INSPECTIONS</p>	<p>All horses entered in the Big Tour classes and those entered in Open Inter-Provincial Team Championship must present for the horse inspection on Tuesday 17th of September 2024. Times will</p>

Please remember that the rider must present his own Horse(s) at the Horse inspection, unless the rider has been excused from this requirement in advance by the President of the Ground Jury or the Chief Steward.</p> <p>Please make sure that you are properly dressed and that your horse is properly turned out for the horse inspection.</p>
BEST TURNED-OUT AWARDS	<p>There will be sponsored prizes awarded to the Best Turned-Out horse and rider combination at the Horse Inspection as well as to the Best Turned-Out Provincial Team. All Open Team horses as well as all Big Tour Horses must be presented at the Horse Inspection and are eligible for the prizes.</p>

APPENDIX A: OBJECTIONS AND APPEALS

Since there are ambiguities in the rules, the following has been specifically prepared to be the protocols and procedures which will be in effect should one wish to have a decision reviewed, report an incident or complain about a perceived injustice at the show.
These procedures are definitive for this show and supersede all others. All decisions will be binding.

THE GROUND JURY

The principal duty of the Ground Jury is the technical judging of all competitions and the determination of their final results. It is up to the Ground Jury to solve all the problems that could arise under its jurisdiction. The Ground Jury is responsible for all aspects of the Field of Play. It is responsible for any problems of the going, the judging, the rules, the results and any other aspects that affect the competition as such.

The protest must be lodged immediately where appropriate, or at least within 30 minutes after the final results of the class have been published. The OC and/or the DSA Representative will facilitate the meeting of the Members of the Ground Jury concerned, for their deliberation. 5. The OC and/or the DSA Representative will notify the Complainant of the outcome of the Protest. Should the protest be upheld, the OC or the DSA Representative will refund the deposit to the Complainant but should the protest be denied, the deposit will be forfeited in favour of DSA. 6. Should the Complainant be dissatisfied with the outcome of the protest, an Appeal may be lodged.

These will be matters of a general nature, not directly affecting the competition such as: complaints about rider registration or eligibility, bad behavior, non competitors riding horses, stabling issues etc.</p>

The protest must be lodged immediately where appropriate, or at least within 30 minutes after the last prize-giving of the show. It is at the sole discretion of the OC to accept or reject a protest outside of this timeframe. 4. The OC will meet with the DSA Representative, the Chief Steward and the Athletes' Representative where appropriate and make a judgment. 5. The OC and/or the DSA Representative will notify the Complainant of the outcome of the Protest. Should the protest be upheld, the OC or the DSA Representative will refund the deposit to the Complainant, but should the protest be denied, the deposit will be forfeited in favour of DSA. 6. Should the Complainant be dissatisfied with the outcome of the protest, an Appeal may be lodged.

This should be lodged with the OC or the DSA Representative 2. A deposit of R2000 must be lodged with the OC or the DSA Representative at the time of the Appeal for which a numbered receipt must be issued. 3. The Appeal must be lodged within 30 minutes of the Complainant being informed of the unsuccessful protest. It is at the sole discretion of the President of the Appeals Committee to accept/reject an Appeal outside of the 30 minutes after the results have been published. 4. The OC or the DSA Representative will facilitate the meeting of the Members of the Appeals Committee for their deliberation. 5. The OC or the DSA Representative will notify the Complainant of the outcome of the Appeal. Should the Appeal be upheld, the OC or the DSA Representative will refund the deposit to the Complainant, but should the Appeal be denied, the deposit will be forfeited in favour of DSA. The decision of the Appeals Committee is final.
