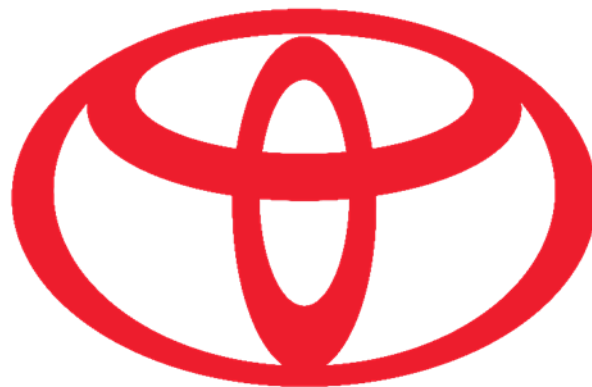

GENERAL CONDITIONS

This event is organised in accordance with:

- SASA Showing Rules and Annexures
 - SAEF General Regulations
- SASA Rules Edition 25 effective 1st January 2025

The event will be run under SASA and SAEF rules unless otherwise stated.

1. Competitors may only ride one horse in each class, except in the Working Classes, where they may ride up to three horses.
2. All Riders and Horses must be registered with a Club, SAEF and SASA. Membership forms may be obtained on the SASA website www.showingsa.co.za or from admin@showingsa.co.za. Temporary SASA Membership of R115
3. SASA will pay entry fees for SASA EDTS competitors in all classes. That includes In Hand and Under Saddle classes. The competitor must be an EDTS member of SASA. Membership is free. EDTS application forms, Rules and Conditions are available at www.showingsa.co.za or from admin@showingsa.co.za EDTS competitors will earn EDTS Victor Ludorum points.
4. Working Hunters will be required to jump a course of approximately 8-12 fences, one of which will be a combination.
5. Should a competitor qualify more than one horse for the championship, he may nominate another rider, who must be a paid-up member of SASA, to show the horse in that championship. However, the competitor must do the individual test required in the Championship.
6. All classes will be run under SASA Rules Edition 25 effective 1st January 2025
7. EVERY COMPETITOR ENTERING THIS SHOW DOES HEREBY INDEMNIFY ANY JUDGE REGISTERED WITH SASA, OFFICIATING AT THIS SHOW, AGAINST ANY CLAIM OF ANY NATURE FROM ANY CAUSE WHATSOEVER.
8. Registered SASA Instructors will earn Victor Ludorum points for pupils.
9. Open Horses may be ridden by the Judge
10. Heights of Horses and Ponies must be stated in the SASA passport.
11. The minimum age of horses shown under saddle shall be 3 years.
12. All competitors, owners and sponsors shall be registered with a club in whose area of jurisdiction they have their principal place of residence, SAEF and SASA and shall be re-registered on 1 January each year. Membership forms may be obtained on the SASA website www.showingsa.co.za or from admin@showingsa.co.za
13. Horses shall be registered with SAEF and SASA.
14. The horse and rider combination will compete as a member of the province where the rider is resident.
15. On no account, and under penalty of disqualification, may any horse take part in any of the showing classes if the horse has been ridden by anyone other than the competitor or judge from the first day of the show until the end of the last class in which that horse competes.
16. A deposit of R20 for a number is included in the entry fee.

Bought and Sold Entries will be allowed as long as the correct documentation is submitted within the correct time frames and the original rider has signed the form. There will be no buying and selling of entries after 10 April 2025. Forms received thereafter will not be accepted.

REFUNDS: No Refunds will be given after closing date of entries. Entries withdrawn before close of date will be refunded less payfast fees. However due to inclement weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances, should it necessitate cancelling the show, 80% of the entry fee will be refunded.

RESTRICTIONS:

All owners & Riders must be members of, and all horses/ponies must be registered with the discipline in which they wish to compete as well as a Club in their Province. The organising committee in consultation with the discipline Representative reserves the right to combine, handicap, divide or cancel classes should this be necessary, always provided such amendments are not in conflict with the rules. Where necessary, classes may be restricted to qualifications. 80% of entry fees will be refunded should the classes be cancelled due to inclement weather conditions.

PRIZEMONEY:

A minimum of 60% net of entry fees less levies and VAT for CSN (Open) classes plus sponsorship and 40% less levies and VAT Provincial (Novice) classes plus sponsorship per class.

- SUBSTITUTIONS:** A substitution is a change of EITHER a horse or rider.
- DRESS:** Jackets Only. Competitors are required to be correctly dressed.
No Provincial or other T/Golf Shirts will be allowed. No Dressage waistcoats will be permitted.
- STABLING:** **R250 per day/night**
Initial bedding is included. Additional bedding will be available at the show office for the competitor's own account. **NO PADDOCKS ALLOWED AT ALL**
- ALL COMPETITORS needing stabling MUST COMPLETE the STABLE BOOKING FORM
- Parades & Displays:** Except in circumstances where special dispensation has been obtained from the Show Director, competitors must take part in any parade or display or Prize giving. Failure to do so may result in forfeiture of any Prizemoney, Grading/Qualification Points and/or Trophies.
- GROOMS MEALS:** TLC Divan 079 988 3939 should you require to pre-book meals for your groom.
- ACCESS:** All horseboxes and floats must be parked in the allocated area provided.
- Competition Rules:** Unless otherwise stated, all classes will be run under the applicable SASA rules
All horseboxes and floats must be parked in the allocated area provided.
- PASSPORTS:** All horses must be in possession of their FEI Passports or Group IX Passports at all shows. Inspections, sampling and random passport checks, may take place at any event. All horses competing in FEI Classes must have FEI passports or FEI Recognition cards and must be registered with the FEI for 2020 Horse Registrations.

FINES IN RESPECT OF PASSPORT VIOLATIONS

AS Per SAEF Fines Regulations of 2024

- HORSE INSPECTION:** Random Passport Checks
Competitors will be fined should there be any omissions or errors in the horse's passport.

MEDICATION CONTROL:

MCP testing as per SAEF Regulations will be done by the appointed Testing Vet.
Laboratory: National Horse Racing Authority, Turffontein Race Course, Turf Club Street.

PROTESTS & APPEALS:

As per SASA General Regulations. All protests and Objections must be done in writing within the required timelines and in receipt of a R750 deposit.

NOTES:

1. All SASA, SAEF and FEI rules, where applicable, shall apply.
2. The organisers reserve the right to cancel, combine, handicap and restrict classes.
3. Telephonic, or emailed entries unaccompanied by the correct entry fees will NOT be accepted.
4. All dogs must be on handheld leads, failure to which a spot fine of R1000 may be incurred
5. Catering will be available.

ENTRY FEE: R490per class. (Entry fees include R47.50 SASA Levy 6.00 EDTS & R30 Medical/Security Levy, R50 Officials Levy (Excluding 15% VAT) and R64.98 KPC Levy Inc. VAT

NON-KPC Members pay R400 temp membership per rider.
