The event will be run under SASA and SAEF rules unless otherwise stated.

1. Competitors may only ride one horse in each class, except in the Working Classes, where they may ride up to three horses.
2. All Riders and Horses must be registered with a Club, SAEF, and SASA. For Membership, see the SASA website www.showingsa.co.za or from admin@showingsa.co.za.
3. SASA will pay entry fees for SASA EDTS competitors in a maximum of 4 Ridden classes per day. The competitor must be an EDTS member of SASA. Membership is free. EDTS application forms, Rules and Conditions are available at www.showingsa.co.za or contact admin@showingsa.co.za for more information. EDTS competitors will earn EDTS Victor Ludorum points.
4. Working Hunters will be required to jump a course of approximately 8-12 fences, one of which will be a combination.
5. Should a competitor qualify more than one horse for the championship, he may nominate another rider, who must be a paid-up member of SASA, to show the horse in that championship. However, the competitor must do the individual test required in the Championship.
6. All classes will be run under SASA Rules Edition 26, effective 1st January 2026
7. EVERY COMPETITOR ENTERING THIS SHOW DOES HEREBY INDEMNIFY ANY JUDGE REGISTERED WITH SASA, OFFICIATING AT THIS SHOW, AGAINST ANY CLAIM OF ANY NATURE FROM ANY CAUSE WHATSOEVER.
8. Registered SASA Instructors will earn Victor Ludorum points for pupils.
9. Open Horses may be ridden by the Judge
10. Heights of Horses and Ponies must be stated in the SASA passport.
11. The minimum age of horses shown under saddle shall be 3 years.
12. All competitors, owners, and sponsors shall be registered with a club in whose area of jurisdiction they have their principal place of residence, SAEF and SASA, and shall be re-registered on 1 January each year. Membership forms may be obtained on the SASA website www.showingsa.co.za
13. Newcomers are open to riders who have never competed in graded classes in any age group. No cross-entry with Graded Classes.
14. Horses shall be registered with SAEF and SASA.
15. The horse and rider combination will compete as a member of the province where the rider is resident.

Bought and Sold Entries will be allowed if the correct documentation is submitted within the correct time frames and the original rider has signed the form. There will be no buying and selling of entries after 26 March 2026

REFUNDS: No Refunds will be given after the closing date of entries. Entries withdrawn before the close of the date will be refunded less PayFast fees. However, due to inclement weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances, should it necessitate cancelling the show, 80% of the entry fee will be refunded.

RESTRICTIONS: All owners & Riders must be members of, and all horses/ponies must be registered with the discipline in which they wish to compete, as well as a Club in their Province. The organising committee, in consultation with the discipline Representative reserves the right to combine, handicap, divide, or cancel classes should this be necessary, always provided such amendments are not in conflict with the rules. Where necessary, classes may be restricted to qualifications. 80% of entry fees will be refunded should the classes be cancelled due to inclement weather conditions.

PRIZEMONEY: A minimum of 40% less levies and VAT plus sponsorship per class.

SUBSTITUTIONS: A substitution is a change of EITHER a horse or rider.

DRESS: Jackets Only. Competitors are required to be correctly dressed. No Provincial or other T/Golf Shirts will be allowed. No Dressage waistcoats will be permitted.

STABLING: R250 per day/night

Initial bedding is included. Additional bedding will be available at the show office for the competitor's own account. **NO PADDOCKS ALLOWED AT ALL**

ALL COMPETITORS needing stabling MUST COMPLETE the STABLE BOOKING FORM

Parades & Displays: Except in circumstances where special dispensation has been obtained from the Show Director, competitors must take part in any parade or display or Prize giving. Failure to do so may result in forfeiture of any Prizemoney, Grading/Qualification Points, and/or Trophies.

ACCESS: All horseboxes and floats must be parked in the allocated area provided.

Competition Rules: Unless otherwise stated, all classes will be run under the applicable SASA rules
All horseboxes and floats must be parked in the allocated area provided.

PASSPORTS: All horses must have their Group IX Passports at all shows. Inspections, sampling and random passport checks may take place at any event.

FINES IN RESPECT OF PASSPORT VIOLATIONS

AS Per SAEF Fines Regulations of 2024

HORSE INSPECTION: Random Passport Checks
Competitors will be fined should there be any omissions or errors in the horse's passport.

MEDICATION CONTROL:

MCP testing as per SAEF Regulations will be done by the appointed Testing Vet.
Laboratory: National Horse Racing Authority, Turffontein Race Course, Turf Club Street.

PROTESTS & APPEALS:

As per SASA General Regulations. All protests and Objections must be done in writing within the required timelines and in receipt of a R750 deposit.

NOTES:

1. All SASA, SAEF, and FEI rules, where applicable, shall apply.
2. The organisers reserve the right to cancel, combine, handicap, and restrict classes.
3. Telephonic or emailed entries unaccompanied by the correct entry fees will NOT be accepted.
4. All dogs must be on handheld leads; failure to which a spot fine of R1000 may be incurred
5. Catering will be available.
